Jonathan Saenz— President of Texas Values

Jonathan Saenz is President of Texas Values. Texas Values is a nonprofit group dedicated to preserving and advancing a culture of family values in the state of Texas. Jonathan's work on these issues spans two decades. Jonathan believes in religious liberty, sanctity of human life, family values, and constitutional rights and has been involved in numerous court cases, including cases before the Texas Supreme Court and the U.S. Supreme Court.

Jonathan is the leading voice in Texas on marriage between one man and one woman and he was instrumental in the passage of Texas laws to protect religious liberty ("Under God" in the Texas pledge, the "One State Under God" license plate, the "Merry Christmas law", the "Pastor Protection Law", Freedom to Serve Children Act, and The First Amendment Defense Act/'Save Chick-fil-A" *Law*), pro-life laws such as the "Choose Life" license plate, the Sonogram law, HB 2 and many others.

Jonathan served as a lawyer for Gianna Jessen, a courageous woman who survived a late-term abortion attempt when she was in the womb.

(Continued from Page 1) attack to the Second Amendment, voting de-regulation, the politicization of the Media and how they have racially divided the country and demonizing law-abiding citizens, it is following the playbook of failed socialist states like my home country Venezuela. It is alarming the similarities and that's why I am looking to help the RCRHC to the best of my abilities.

As we are all aware of the dark cloud surrounding the presidential election in 2020, it drives home the message that the integrity of our voting system is under attack. In Venezuela, the regime took over the Electoral branch and they have never lost an election since!

I am pleased that early this month, the Texas State Senate passed Senate Bill 7, an election integrity measure, which Republican State Senator Bryan Hughes (R) describes as a bill aimed to make it *"easy to vote and hard to cheat."* This bill is about making it easy to vote and hard to cheat. We had a long debate. Scores of amendments were offered and at the end of the day the Texas Senate passed a strong election integrity bill that we can be proud of," he said. However, many Democrats continue to reject such proposals contending election integrity measures similar to voter suppression. "As I see this bill, it's a pure case of suppression," Texas State Sen. Borris Miles (D) said. "There are some things in here that are really offensive. This hurts to the core." Texas Tribune, April 1. 2021.
