Senator Bob Hall—Trusted Conservative Leader

In the 86th Legislative Session, Texas Senator Bob Hall, was appointed Chairman of the Senate Committee on Agriculture. He is currently Vice-Chairman of Committee on Veteran Affairs & Border Security, a member of Education, Health and Human Service, Local Government and State Affairs Senate Committees. He has earned the reputation of being open-minded and willing to discuss ideas but absolutely unwavering in holding to his core conservative principles and Judeo-Christian values. He is a man who believes in the Declaration of Independence and follows the Constitution. He is pro-life, pro-gun, pro-property rights, pro Judeo-Christian conservative values, a staunch proponent of the free market, fiscally re-

sponsible and pro-limited government.

After the past legislative session, Senator Hall was named in the prestigious Rice University study by the Political Science Department as the number one most Conservative Senator in Texas.

Senator Hall has proven himself to be a true champion of liberty. He graduated from the Citadel in Charleston, South Carolina with a degree in Electrical Engineering and received a Regular Commission as a 2nd Lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force.

Upon graduation, Bob began his active duty as a Systems Engineer working to develop the Minuteman

Missile System during the Cold War at Norton AFB in California, where he achieved the rank of Captain. Following his service, he owned and operated an engineering consulting company. Elected Senator to Senate District 2.

School Board Oversight—Amy Johanneson

The May 1st Rockwall ISD election brought us three newly elected board members: Dr. Sherry Packer (Place 1), Frank Counselman (Place 2), and Linda Duran (Place 3). These three prevailed after a much contested race and we are looking to holding them accountable to the role and responsibilities of their office.

The three new members were sworn in at the May 17th school board meeting. During the public comments period, there was much testimony which included data supporting rescinding the mask mandate immediately, as well as many concerned parents speaking out about matters being taught in the curriculum, as well as the amount of time their students were learning via tech-

nology as opposed to in-person instruction.

Unfortunately a heated debate broke out amongst the parents as a result of President Jon Bailey elected to move the public comments and agenda resulted in parents who were in attendance to witness their children being recognized having to wait longer.

Following public comments and recognitions, the board broke for 1-1/2 hours for executive session and business resumed after 9 p.m. As per usual, it was a late night, and the majority of business items were addressed between 9 and 10:30 p.m. It is unfortunate that the current proceedings do not encourage public interaction. Those of us who are dedicated and attend meetings regularly are committed

to attend, engage our elected officials, ask for change in proceedings, and represent all constituents with the goals of keeping RISD conservative, focused on core curriculum, and not party to national political games in which our children are the innocent bystanders. We believe strongly there is no room for indoctrination in our classrooms!

Legislature Corner Jose—Nunez

It is clear to us that RCRHC stands proud for our belief of the value of life and want to be part of the solution of brining awareness to the pro-life message. As we prepare ourselves to host our 1st Annual Sanctity of Life banquet on May 29th, we considered appropriate to bring to your attention a very important bill that was signed into law on May 19th: Fetal “Heartbeat” Bill SB 8.

This bill does not specify a specific time frame but would ban abortions after a fetal heartbeat can be detected, which proponents say can

be enforced by private citizens empowered to sue abortion providers and others who help someone get an abortion after six weeks, for example, by driving them to an abortion clinic. The law takes effect in September of 2021.

“Our creator endowed us with the right to life and yet millions of children lose their right to life every year because of abortion, “Gov. Abbott said in the bill signing ceremony; and on his tweeter he expressed that “This bill ensures the life of every child with a heartbeat will be saved from the ravages of abortion.

For pro-life supporters, this law is a major step to protect the unborn child and guarantee the accountability of medical service providers that practice abortions in our state.
