Lt. Col. Allen West—Candidate for Texas Governor

Lt. Col. Allen West (R), retired, is a Christian constitutional conservative, combat veteran, and former member of the U.S. Congress. He is the third of four generations of military servicemen in his family. During his 22-year career in the U.S. Army, Lieutenant Colonel West served in several combat zones and received many honors including a Bronze Star, three Meritorious Service Medals, three Army Commendation Medals, one with Valor device, and a Valorous Unit Award. In 1993, he was

named the US Army ROTC Instructor of the Year.

In November of 2010, Allen was elected to the U.S. Congress representing Florida's 22nd District. As a member of the 112th Congress, he sat on the Small Business and Armed Services Committees and was instrumental in passage of the 2011 and 2012 National Defense Authorization Acts.

He is a Newsmax TV Contributor, Senior Fellow of the Media Re-

search Center, and author of Guardian of the Republic: An American Ronin's Journey to Family, Faith and Freedom, Hold Texas, Hold the Nation: Victory or Death, and We Can Overcome: An American Black Conservative Manifesto.

Texas Heartbeat Law Stays in Effect

The status of the Texas Heartbeat Law is that it stays in effect in Texas. The United States Supreme Court did not give a ruling on the Texas Heartbeat Law this past Monday.

The Texas Heartbeat Law took effect on September 1, 2021. The result of the Texas Heartbeat Law is that more than 100 lives are being saved every day. According to Natalie Neal, Nov. 22, 2021 Press Release, "There are two cases before the U.S. Supreme Court on this issue: one brought by the Biden Department of Justice, and the other which has been brought by abortion groups." According to Jonathan Saenz, President and Attorney for Texas Val-

ues, "We are thankful that the Texas Heartbeat Law remains in effect, and lives are being saved every day in Texas because when a heartbeat is detected, that baby is protected. We estimate that over 12,000 babies have been saved since the law went into effect on September 1st, and we are keeping a daily count on texasheartbeatlaw.com." The Supreme Court hears arguments in the lawsuit challenging the Mississippi abortion ban today December 1st.

The Rockwall County Republican Hispanic Club (RCRHC) strongly supports the Texas Heartbeat Law and pro-life efforts. We are thankful to individuals that answered a RCRHC Alert and

Call To Action with a Pro-Life counter-protest at the Rockwall Square. Successfully, we showed up in numbers and we were able to standup for the unborn.

RCRHC will kick-off the 2022 Sanctity of Life efforts January 1, 2022. Details will be provided in January's newsletter.

 Director of the Booker T. Washington
 Initiative (BTWI) for the Texas Pub-
 lic Policy Foundation.

In July of 2020, Mr. West was elected
 Chairman of the Republican Party of
 Texas by an overwhelming majority
 of State delegates.

West is an avid distance runner, a
 Master SCUBA diver, and in his
 spare time he enjoys cheering his
 beloved Tennessee Volunteers.

Lt. Col. West is a former commis-
 sioned officer in the Texas State
 Guard. Lt. Col. West is a legacy life
 member of the Veterans of Foreign
 Wars, life member of the American
 Legion, life member of the Association
 of the United States Army, the Society
 of the First Infantry Division, 4th In-
 fantry Division, and 101st Airborne
 Division. He is a Patriot Life Member
 (Benefactor) and Board of Directors
 member of the National Rifle Associa-
 tion and Life Member (Benefactor) of
 the Texas State Rifle Association. He
 is an inductee into the University of
 Tennessee Army ROTC Hall of Fame.

 may have another Buñuelo." We

 Abuelo and a Buñuelo. At least he


