During the 87th Legislative Session, Central Texans' election to send in a conservative fighter was quickly met with appointments of Rep. Slawson to the powerful Calendars, State Affairs, and Pensions. Investments & Financial Services These appointments are committees. especially remarkable for being the first freshmen appointment to Calendars since 1985 and the first time a freshman served simultaneously on Calendars and State Affairs since 1973!

for a freshman legislator, she carried the historic Texas Heartbeat Act (SB 8) in the House, passing the most significant pro-life bill in Texas' history!

In the post-session, independent analysis of legislators published by Rice University, Rep. Slawson is ranked the Most

Ann is a native Texan, born in Corpus Christi and raised in a small, rural, railroad town, Teague, Texas. She attended Baylor University and completed her degree in Education at the University of Houston. She taught public school and private kindergarten before beginning the work of administering religious education in a succession of Baptist Churches across the nation.

In 1993, she became a volunteer in the Washington, D.C. office of Concerned Women for America, convincing U.S. Senators and U.S. Congressmen to pass conservative Christian values in public

policy. Upon her return to Texas she was selected to become a leader in the organization and in 2006 became the State Director. She has served on their national board of trustees as well as the Board of Trustees for Criswell College, in Dallas, and the Rockwall County Republican Women's Club as Vice-President of Legislation.

She has represented Republican voters at the County and State Conventions for several election cycles and has also been active in the campaigns of candidates for public office across

the state and nation.

She has been married for sixty-four years to Hays, who served as an attorney for the Federal Aviation Agency in assignments in Fort Worth, Houston, Seattle, Chicago and Washington, D.C. before retiring to Rockwall in 1993

and entering private practice in Dallas.



They have two daughter, six grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

RCRHC is honored that Senator Bob Hall will join us for the **2022 United** for Life Banquet. Senator Hall is is a strong advocate to Pro-Life efforts in Texas and supports RCRHC's efforts with our Sanctity of Life work.

Senator Hall interviewed Senator Bryan Hughes (SD1), Chair of State Affairs Committee.

Senator Hall: Hearings on Pro-Life, 2nd Amendment, Senate Bill 8 was a Priority Bill important to the conservatives and one of the Republican Party priority items. One of our planks in our platform. Senator Hughes put together a very good bill which we both were joint authors

Senator Hughes: Senate Bill 8 recognizes the unborn baby in the mother's womb - this Bill recognizes the baby's life - the heartbeat. This Bill states that where there is a heartbeat detected – we are going to protect that life. Every life from conception to natural death is precious and a gift from God to be protected. We are doing everything we can to save every baby. A dozen states have passed Heartbeat Laws winding their way to the Supreme Court. This Bill is different from the standpoint that it will be implemented quicker and save more babies right away because as soon as that heartbeat is detected then the baby is protected.

<u>Senator Hall</u>: There is no real argument against that as soon as the heartbeat is detected there is life.

Senator Hughes: Over in the House, Rep. Shelby Slawson a very sharp and a new member in the House from Central Texas – she's carrying the companion Bill – very impressive new member in the House, is a strong advocate of
